The **DATE conference** addresses all aspects of research into technologies for electronic and embedded system engineering. The two Special Focus Days for the DATE 2012 conference are:

More Than Moore: A Special Day on More-than-Moore technologies (MtM) will be organised. After a broad overview of the MtM field, dedicated talks will address specific technologies including ams-rf, power and 3D integration, and applications such as energy and healthcare.

e-Mobility: The e-Mobility Special Day will take up the latest trend towards hybrid and fully electric vehicles by discussing upcoming issues to be addressed by the design automation, microelectronics and embedded system communities. The major challenge is to smooth the way in developing the high requirements for the electronic systems inside an electric vehicle. Important topics to be discussed are among many others control and operation strategies to optimise energy consumption and recovery, electromagnetic interference due to high and low voltage electronics, and efficient vehicle to grid solutions with smart recharging capabilities.

exhibition theatre

The exhibition theatre programme is a mix of panel discussions and user presentations that give exhibition visitors and conference delegates a dynamic overview of key technical and business issues in electronic and embedded systems design. Submissions are invited from exhibiting companies and projects, industry consortia, technology groups, standards bodies, or any person with opinions on future industry trends.



the exhibition

The DATE exhibition will run for three days (Tuesday-Thursday) in halls on the ground floor of the congress centre. The halls benefit from natural daylight and are largely pillar free.

DATE also arranges a number of special events and features on the show floor to allow busy conference delegates more time and justification to visit the show floor. An opening night drinks reception, extended delegate coffee breaks, show-floor catering areas and an exhibition theatre of industry themed presentations. All these activities are intended to make DATE a more attractive place for industry professionals to do business.

DATE continues to be a growing event with a 40% increase of exhibition visitor numbers at DATE 2011 (890) compared to DATE 2010. In addition the overall number of conference attendees (1,400) increased by 8% compared to the successful DATE 2010 event.
