The **DATE conference** addresses all aspects of research into technologies for electronic and embedded system engineering. It covers the design process, test, and automation tools for electronics ranging from integrated circuits to distributed embedded systems. This includes both hardware and embedded software design issues. The conference scope also includes the elaboration of design requirements and new architectures for challenging application fields such as telecoms, wireless communications, multimedia, avionic and automotive systems.

Topics are arranged according to four groupings:

- **D** Design Methods, Tools, Algorithms and Languages
- A Application Design
- **T** Test Methods, Tools and Innovative Experiences
- E Embedded Systems Software

Companies involved in innovative industrial designs are particularly encouraged to submit papers to foster the feedback from real-world design to research.

DATE also hosts a number of **special sessions**, events within the main technical programme such as panels, hot-topic sessions and embedded tutorials to highlight and inform about special-interest and emerging topics.
